

eTwinning at school Špičák

In the school year 2012/2013 we follow a two-year tradition in eTwinning. At the beginning it is a good idea to look back. So we summarize the previous two years, after which our school was involved in the networking of schools' e-twinning.

What is eTwinning?

E-Twinning ("e" as electronic, European and "twinning" as pairing, networking) is aimed at promoting cooperation of students and teachers of primary and secondary schools within the European Union. eTwinning can be characterized as a project in which two more schools from different countries to implement the educational activity remotely - through information and communication technologies. Cooperation can take place at several levels: between teachers, groups of teachers, librarians, directors, students or whole classes. eTwinning can become a natural, integral part of the school life of pupils, students and teachers. It is an opportunity for all young Europeans, who may participate in the study of the educational project with partners from other European countries. Such experience is very important for strengthening the European dimension in education for young people's awareness about the diversity of multilingual and multicultural society and educate their skills to live and work anywhere in Europe.

E-Twinning Who is it for?

The e-Twinning initiative is open to all types of primary and secondary schools is not the type of educational grant program, which exist within the European Union - has defined the criteria for participation or involvement or deadlines for proposals. eTwinning is a service that provides a framework for international cooperation schools, which can easily establish partnerships and carry out such activity (international educational projects), which they considered appropriate, where they have determined the beginning and the end of cooperation with partner schools. VI. B is involved in the project "Let's world and mak-flower" with Hungarian, Polish and French school. But we have not found even one common lesson, so communication was limited to Sunday evening and children, as our and foreign forgetting Twinschat cooperation and slowly disappeared. Closer relationship we have with the Polish school, where we exchanged postcards each other. This project was at the end when the school year ended, and this class will participate in a new project in the coming school year.

VII. A developed together with the Greek school in Arte project "One year in our lives." The

children worked on presentations in which represented his family, his school, his town. We also focused on the important religious festival ie. Christmas and Easter. In the project we also write postcards and even our kids got hand- made cards from Greek Arty. The presentations included also quizzes that our children or Greek solved and were deservedly rewarded.

VIII. grade was the most successful in this school year. Project "Day in My Life", which started in the academic year 2010/2011 with small presentations about our school, our city and thematic presentations on important events in our country and Turkey, continued the weekly e-twinning skype transmission. Friday's English lesson we spent in the computer lab. Always we have already decided on the theme and children should find out as much information as possible from its counterpart. From the beginning of the cooperation had been stalled, children with shy, but after we appeared in the Turkish television, stirred the fullest. This collaboration culminated in the visit of Turkish students in our school the week after Easter soon. The preparation was really hard, but it was a wonderful week for which none of our or Turkish students forget. Another important recognition was "Quality label", which took over the project leader at the conference in Most. Unfortunately, this collaboration ended in June 2012, when Turkish students finished attendance partner primary schools.

For the ninth year it was the saddest year. They cooperated in the project "Nice to meet you" together with Cretan school in Chania. The most beautiful in the whole project was that the children found friends some still correspond, exchange cards, and are in contact on social networks. Some of the students even went to Greek Chania on holidays. The project ended well because both Greek, and Czech students have left their primary school and entered for further study in secondary schools.

Upcoming new school year 2012/2013

VI. A under the guidance of the teacher Truhlářová will be involved in two e-Twinning projects. The first, on which the teacher collaborate with the teacher of Czech and Art Dana Bílá, titled "Calendar-calendar-Kalendarz" will apply to the Czech language, art, and will be included as well in class lessons. As the name suggests, we will create a calendar both visually and by small we write prose or poetry. Once a month you plan to transfer via skype when our neighbor we will read their calendar in their language (Polish and Slovak) and we're going to read our creations in Czech. The aim is clear: to become familiar with the language of our closest neighbours. In addition, this class will build on the previous cooperation project "Nice to meet you" with Greece Chania and Mrs. Aggeliki Galanaki teacher. On the topic of collaboration in English we will be discussing during the month of September.

VII. B at the end of the previous school year participated in the e-twinning project, which was launched as a project of June "From garbage to garden." This project is a precursor Comenius project that will claim this year's autumn following "preparatory visit" to which our school is awarded a grant from the National Agency and the teacher Mrs Truhlářová will go to French Le Mans, where he meets teachers from France, Poland, Germany, Spain and Turkey. During the visit, they will create a Comenius project and then it will be only our National agency to approve the project, and our students will be able in two years to travel to these countries.

VIII. A it will continue to broach the project with a school in Greek art. We will work again in the presentations, we will try to establish a solid hour and we will be able to communicate with the Greek students over Skype and use English both written as well as spoken. I hope that the cooperation will develop enough kids to get their friends for a long time.

For the ninth year in this school year it is prepared interesting project "Forgotten Children games," and we will work with Turkish school, the same teacher Ozge Sen, but with other children, because, as already mentioned, the Turkish students went to high school. I hope we can cooperation as in previous years.
